With live music seven nights a week from 7pm to 2am, The Cabaret has re-energized the live music and performance scene in Miami. "The Cast" of The Cabaret consists of extremely talented local Miami performers that had to audition for a position as a server or bartender. They are all singers; many also play piano, guitar, drums, or saxophone. Specialty acts such as old fashioned burlesque performers, aerialists, comedians, poets and circus performers round out the variety of acts creating a full on cabaret.

This intimate venue is reminiscent of an underground New York cabaret. The décor is French baroque with antique gold framed paintings and mirrors, multiple crystal chandeliers, red velvet curtains and a white baby grand piano.
